\*\*Business Administration and Management Field of Study (Students with transfer credit for statistics are required to take STAT 3331 as a prerequisite for Finance courses, which will count as a General Elective. It may not double count.)

#Students not placed into MATH 1314 start with MATH 1313 as a prerequisite; otherwise, start with MATH 1314 since MATH 1313 is best taken immediately prior to STAT 3331.

>3000-4000 level business courses, except for MIS 3300, MARK 3337, ENTR 3310 and ENTR 3312, are not open to non-business majors unless required for their major, a business minor or special program; these students should take core courses instead. Students are not eligible to change their major to business if they do not meet the requirements by 45 credit hours.

Students should meet with their academic advisor to formulate their own plan.
