**Business Administration and Management Field of Study

>3000-4000 level business courses, except for MARK 3337, ENTR 3310 and ENTR 3312, are not open to non-business majors unless required for their major, a business minor or special program; these students should take core courses instead. Students are not eligible to change their major to business if they do not meet the requirements by the semester they complete 45 credit hours.

Students should meet with their academic advisor to formulate their own plan. Consult accounting advisor for information on special programs: Professional Program in Accountancy (PPA), Internal Audit, and Oil&Gas Accounting to meet electives.
